James Jacob Klein, the founder of the family, came from Prussia.

He was highly educated; he was a chemist (we now call a pharmacist); he spoke seven languages and played the violin. He was possibly here about 1845. He was of the Jewish faith but married a gentile named Caroline. He moved to Indiana in 1856 and stayed there long enough to get a divorce (SC did not have a divorce law). He next married a girl from Syracuse, NY named Caroline Gaetta Silverman. He owned Klein's Drugstore located next door to Bethel Presbyterian Church. He and his wife had seven children, 6 girls and 1 boy. John Marcus Klein, the only son was born 1858. When his father died he took over the family business. He married Lucille McTeer. His sisters made many contributions to life in Walterboro. The house which the family built still exists at 421 Wichman St. and is occupied by a member of the family, Lucille Fingers Powers. Outstanding presentation on an outstanding Walterboro Family.

The obituary on Abraham Padgett written in Mar of 1904 states he was a member of the Bethel Methodist Church, Hendersonville Circuit. Question: Could the date Oct 19 1892 used as a death date

be the date he became a member of Bethel Methodist Church? We feel that it is important to use the Mar of 1904 as Abraham Padgett's date of death due to his living with his son Joseph D. Padgett in the 1900 Census and the fact that the obituary was written in Mar of 1904. Those who are interested in researching this fact will find Abraham Padgett in the 1900 Census under Joseph O. Padgett living in Colleton County, SC, Bells Township, South Carolina.
