In 1741, he moved to South Carolina and was raised by an uncle. He first married Margaret Kelly unfortunately there were no children from this union. He next married Anne Wilson. They had 9 children, including Captain Joseph Glover. Col. Joseph Glover owned several plantations in the Walterboro area. He was imprisoned by the British when Charleston surrendered. He was the commander of Ft. Dorchester and furnished supplies to the Continental forces. He attended the General Assembly that met in Jacksonboro in 1781. He died in 1783 and is buried at Grove Hall Plantation in the St. James District.

Later, other areas such as Florida and California became important and the production declined. Today, Adams Run is a small village but there are several locations listed on the National Registry of Historic Places.
